**AN ACT RELATING TO EXCLUSIONS OF INCOME IN THE OLD AGE
ASSISTANCE AFFAIRS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The ninth sentence of the first paragraph of section 1 of
2 chapter 118A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words added by section 1 of chapter 788 of
4 the acts of 1972 and inserting in place thereof the following
5 words: — that no increase in payments made to the aged per-
6 son under the provisions of the federal social security act shall
7 be deemed to be income of such aged person.
