AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SIX-MONTH MANDATORY SENTENCE FOR THE SECOND CONVICTION FOR USING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of
2 section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
3 amended by chapter 418 of the acts of 1974, is hereby amend-
4 ed by striking out, in lines 23 and 24, the words "thirty days
5 nor more than two and one half years, or by a fine of not more
6 than one thousand dollars, or by both such fine and imprison-
7 ment" and inserting in place thereof the words: — six months
8 nor more than two and one-half years, or by both such im-
9 prisonment and a fine of not more than one thousand dollars,
10 and such sentence shall not be suspended.
