AN ACT ALLOWING THE REGISTRAR TO SELL COPIES OF CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION TO ALL DRIVING MEMBERS OF A FAMILY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 701 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby further
3 amended by adding the following two sentences of the first
4 paragraph:

5 If there are several driving members of a family, the owner
6 shall make a request for additional copies of such registration,
7 so that each driving member may be able to carry the regis-
8 tration on his/her person at all times. The registrar, or his
9 duly authorized agents, upon such request, shall furnish at a
10 reasonable fee the additional copies of said registration in
11 such form as shall be deemed proper and valid.
