AN ACT REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF MOTOR BOAT OPERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 7, the following section: —
- 3 *Section 7A.* No person shall operate a motor boat requiring
- 4 a certificate of number without first obtaining a license to op-
- 5 erate such class of boat, prior to June first, nineteen hundred
- 6 and seventy-six. Application for a license to operate motor
- 7 boats may be made by any person, except a person who has
- 8 been licensed and whose license is not in force because of re-
- 9 vocation or suspension or whose right to operate is suspended
- 10 by the director; but before such license is granted the appli-
- 11 cant shall pass such examination as to his qualifications as the
- 12 director shall require and no license shall be issued until the
- 13 director or his authorized agent is satisfied that the applicant
- 14 is a proper person to receive it.
