AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POSSESSION OF FIREARMS BY
NON-RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the word "firearms," be-
3 fore the word "rifles" as such word appears in paragraph (g)
4 of said Section 129-C, and in paragraph (h) of said Section
5 129-C, and in paragraph (i) of said Section 129-C.
