AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN
PERSONS BY THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 9A of chapter 22
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 eighth sentence, as most recently amended by section 2 of
4 chapter 925 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in place thereof
5 the following sentence: — No person who has not reached his
6 nineteenth birthday nor any person who has passed his
7 thirtieth birthday shall be enlisted for the first time as an of-
8 ficer of the division of state police.

1 SECTION 2. Section 4 of chapter 23 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence and insert-
3 ing in place thereof the following sentence: — Such number
4 of inspectors as the commissioner may deem necessary shall
5 be persons who, before their employment as such, have had
6 at least three years' experience as building construction work-
7 men.

1 SECTION 3. Section 5 of said chapter 23 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the third sentence.

1 SECTION 4. Section 3 of chapter 28 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the third sentence and insert-
3 ing in place thereof the following sentence: — The commis-
4 sion may appoint and remove such officials and employees as

5 the work of the commission may require, including officers
 6 and members of the police force, and may from time to time
 7 assign to such officials and employees such duties as the work
 8 of the commission may require, subject to chapter thirty and
 9 thirty-one, except as provided by chapter five hundred and

1 Section 1. The first paragraph of section 3A of chapter 22
 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
 3 words "and any person who has not worked for
 4 the following ten years — No person who has not worked for
 5 a continuous period of one year and seven months who has passed his
 6 thirty-fifth birthday shall be entitled for the first time to an ap-
 7 pointment in the division of state police."

1 Section 2. Section 4 of chapter 22 of the General Laws is
 2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and insert-
 3 ing in place thereof the following sentence — Such person
 4 of fourteen or the commission may deem necessary to
 5 be persons who before their appointment as such, have had
 6 at least three years' experience as following construction work-
 7 men.

1 Section 3. Section 5 of said chapter 22 is hereby amended
 2 by striking out the first sentence.

1 Section 4. Section 6 of chapter 22 of the General Laws is
 2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and insert-
 3 ing in place thereof the following sentence — The commis-
 4 sion may employ and employ such clerks and employees as
