By Mr. Tobin, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1011) of Arthur H. Tobin and Irene V. McHugh for legislation to authorize the state teachers' retirement system to grant a pension to Irene V. McHugh, the widow of Leo T. McHugh. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO GRANT A PENSION TO IRENE V. MC HUGH, THE WIDOW OF LEO T. MC HUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of promoting moral obligation and insuring
2 equity and justice, the Massachusetts state teachers' retire-
3 ment board is hereby authorized to grant to Irene V. McHugh,
4 79 Hall Place, Quincy, the widow of Leo T. McHugh, a former
5 employee of the Quincy public schools for approximately
6 twenty years, who died before a medical panel could examine
7 him because of the failure of the commonwealth to appoint its
8 representative thereto in a timely manner, a pension under
9 the provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws in
10 the same amount as if the medical panel had examined said
11 Leo T. McHugh, retired him thereunder, and authorized pen-
12 sion for his widow.
