

SENATE No. 1020

By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1020) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to provide that state, Metropolitan District Commission, and Capitol Police shall be paid a salary commensurate with salaries paid to police in the cities of Boston, Cambridge and Quincy. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT STATE, METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION, AND CAPITOL POLICE SHALL BE PAID A SALARY COMMENSURATE WITH SALARIES PAID TO POLICE IN THE CITIES OF BOSTON, CAMBRIDGE AND QUINCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 the state police, metropolitan district commission police and
- 3 capitol police shall be paid a salary commensurate with sal-
- 4 aries paid to police in the cities of Boston, Cambridge and
- 5 Quincy.
