AN ACT REQUIRING THE STATE SECRETARY TO KEEP A CURRENT LISTING OF LOCAL ACCEPTANCE STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by adding the following sentence: — The state secretary
3 shall keep a list of such statutes, shall annually revise said list
4 to include any amendments thereto or new enactments thereof
5 and shall mail said list annually to each city and town.
