In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-eight.

**AN ACT REQUIRING THE REAL ESTATE TAX BILLS TO DISPLAY THE  
COUNTY TAX RATES FOR EACH CITY AND TOWN.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 3A of chapter 60 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following sentence: — Every bill or  
3 notice for a real or personal property tax shall have printed  
4 thereon in a conspicuous place the estimated amount of the  
5 general tax which will go to fund county government, such  
6 estimate to be based on the county's requested budget.
