The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN EQUALIZED VALUATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of special or general law to
2 the contrary, the state tax commission shall conduct a thorough
3 review of the most recent equalized valuation of the town of
4 Avon. If the commission finds that an error exists in the said
5 valuations to the extent that the full value tax rate has been
6 affected by more than fifty cents per thousand, it shall make
7 the appropriate adjustment in any state aid formula affected
8 thereby for fiscal year ending June thirtieth nineteen hundred
9 and seventy-nine. The town of Avon may appeal any determi-
10 nation made by the commission pursuant to this act in the
11 manner provided in chapter thirty-eight of the general laws.
