By Mr. Mastrocola, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1230) of G. F. Daniels and Frank J. Mastrocola, Jr., for legislation to authorize and direct the Department of Public Works to lay out and construct Market street in the cities of Everett and Chelsea. Transportation.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO LAY OUT AND CONSTRUCT MARKET STREET IN THE CITIES OF EVERETT AND CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to lay out and construct the extension of Market
- 3 street in the cities of Chelsea and Everett.

The following is a list of the names of the persons who were elected to the office of Justice of the Peace for the year 1900, and who were sworn in on the 1st day of January, 1900.

The Government of the State

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION AND VOTING OF CITIZENS IN THE STATE OF TENNESSEE.

Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, at its regular session, at Nashville, Tennessee, on the 1st day of January, 1900.

1. The purpose of this act is to provide for the registration and voting of citizens in the State of Tennessee, and to provide for the election of Justices of the Peace.
