**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE RE-DETERMINATION OF SENIOR CITIZENS RENT IN PUBLIC HOUSING TAKE PLACE EVERY TWO YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The provisions of any general or special law or any rule, or
- 2 regulation of the Department of Community Affairs Notwith-
- 3 standing, the Department of Community Affairs is hereby au-
- 4 thorized and directed to amend its rules and regulations on
- 5 annual rent re-determination to provide that the rent re-de-
- 6 termination for senior citizens households take place every
- 7 two years not annually.
