AN ACT IMPOSING A MINIMUM SENTENCE FOR CAUSING THE DEATH OF PERSONS AS THE RESULT OF IMPROPER OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-four G of chapter ninety of the General
2 Laws, as inserted by chapter two hundred and twenty-seven
3 of the acts of 1976, is hereby amended by striking out the
4 words "or by a fine of not less than three hundred nor more
5 than three thousand dollars, or both." and inserting in place
6 thereof the following words: — and by a fine of not less than
7 three hundred nor more than three thousand dollars.
