AN ACT GRANTING PERMANENT CIVIL SERVICE STATUS TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The personnel administrator is hereby authorized and
2 directed to record the following employees of the city of

4 administration as permanent employees of said city, classified
5 under the civil service law and rules, notwithstanding their
6 failure to take an open competitive civil service examination
