AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CORRECTIVE CHANGES RELATIVE TO THE LAW AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF FISHERIES, WILDLIFE AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN GEORGETOWN TO JOANNE C. STANLEY AND TO CONVEY OTHER LAND TO WILLIAM E. HANDREN IN EXCHANGE FOR CERTAIN LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of the first paragraph of sec-
2 tion 1 of Chapter 881 of the Acts of 1977 is hereby amended
3 by striking out, in line 2, the words "Commissioner of Fish-
4 eries, Wildlife and Recreational Vehicles" and inserting in
5 place thereof the words: — Director of Fisheries and Wild-
6 life.

1 SECTION 2. The first sentence of section 2 of said Chapter
2 881 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 1 and 2, the
3 words "Commissioner of Fisheries, Wildlife, and Recreational
4 Vehicles" and inserting in place thereof the words: — Di-
5 rector of Fisheries and Wildlife; and by striking out, in line
6 3, the word "successor": and inserting in place thereof the
7 word: — designee.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
