AN ACT AMENDING THE REGULATIONS FOR TRADE SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 93 is hereby amended by adding the following sec-
- 2 tion 21 H;
- 3 "Any person who wishes to establish a degree granting in-
- 4 stitution may be authorized to do so by the Board of Higher
- 5 Education for a period not to exceed three years for the pur-
- 6 pose of receiving approval after the one year disqualifying
- 7 period by the Board of Higher Education to become a chart-
- 8 ered degree granting institution notwithstanding any pro-
- 9 vision to the contrary in Section 21 A through G.
- 10 Whoever operates or maintains such an institution for the
- 11 purposes under this section shall be required to comply with
- 12 any rules or regulations of the Board of Higher Education
- 13 regarding the operation of said facility.
