AN ACT REQUIRING INSURANCE POLICIES TO BE WRITTEN IN A FORM
THAT CAN BE EASILY UNDERSTOOD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 2A of Chapter 175 of the General Laws as inserted
- 2 by Chapter 801 of the Acts of 1977 is hereby further amended
- 3 by striking out in clause (a) of subsection 1 of said section
- 4 2A the word "fifty" and inserting in place thereof the word
- 5 "forty-five".
