AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OF TWO ADDITIONAL ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES FOR THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law to the contrary, the licensing authority of the city of
3 New Bedford is hereby authorized to terminate two seasonal
4 licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages granted under
5 the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred
6 and thirty-eight of the General Laws and to grant two addi-
7 tional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages under the
8 provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and
9 thirty-eight, provided, that the number of seasonal licenses for
10 the sale of all alcoholic beverages authorized for said city to
11 grant under the provisions of said section seventeen is reduced
12 by two such licenses.
