AN ACT RELATIVE TO AMBULANCE SERVICE REGULATIONS, INSOFAR AS THEY PERTAIN TO AMBULANCE CREWS MAKING SCHEDULED RUNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 111C of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1
