AN ACT REGULATING THE ELIGIBILITY OF LIFE PRISONERS TO CAMP.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 127 of the General Laws, Section 83B, as most re-  
2 cently amended by Chapter 172, Section 2 of the Acts of 1973,  
3 is hereby amended by striking out the words "prisoners sen-  
4 tenced to life who have served twelve years, except a prisoner  
5 serving a life sentence for first degree murder," on lines five  
6 and six and inserting in place thereof the following: — pris-  
7 oners sentenced to life for first degree murder who have served  
8 five years and prisoners sentenced to life for second degree  
9 murder who have served three years.
