AN ACT REQUIRING INSURANCE POLICIES TO BE WRITTEN IN A
FORM THAT CAN BE EASILY UNDERSTOOD

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection 1(f) of Section 2B of chapter 175 of
2 the General Laws as appearing in chapter 801 of the acts of
3 1977 is hereby amended to read as follows: — The organiza-
4 tion of the content of the policy is conducive to understand-
5 ability of the form.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
