**AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE THE IRRETRIEVABLE BREAKDOWN OF
DIVORCE LAW.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1A of chapter 208, as added by chapter
2 698 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the second sentence the following: —

4 "The sworn affidavit may be accepted by the court as prima
5 facie evidence of the existence of the irretrievable breakdown
6 of the marriage."

1 SECTION 2. Said section of said chapter is hereby further
2 amended by striking out in the first sentence of the second
3 paragraph the words "dissolution agreement" and inserting
4 in place thereof the words "separation agreement" and by
5 striking out in the last paragraph the words "dissolution
6 agreement" and inserting in place thereof the words "separa-
7 tion agreement."
