1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of one mem-
2 ber of the Senate, one member of the House of Representa-
3 tives, three members of the Department of Public Works or
4 their designees, one member of the Department of Environ-
5 mental Management or his/her designee, one member of the
6 Department of Public Safety or his/her designee, one member
7 of the Massachusetts Historical Commission or his/her desig-
8 nee, one member of the Merrimack Valley Planning Commis-
9 sion, and a member of the local governing bodies of Grove-
10 land, West Newbury, Merrimac and Haverhill, be established
11 for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the
12 Rocks Village Bridge with regard to making the necessary
13 repairs and maintaining the historical authenticity of the
14 Bridge. Said commission shall also study sources of funding
15 proposed recommendations. Said commission shall report its
16 findings to the General Court by no later than the last Wed-
17 nesday in December of nineteen-hundred and seventy-nine.
