**AN ACT RELATIVE TO RECIPROCITY FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE
OPERATORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 30, and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following: — A recreational vehicle owned by a resident in
- 4 another state shall be deemed to be properly registered for the
- 5 purposes of this chapter if it is registered in accordance with
- 6 the laws of the state in which its owner resides, but only to
- 7 the extent that a similar exemption or privilege is granted
- 8 under the laws of that state for recreational vehicles registered
- 9 in this state.
