## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine.

### AN ACT TO MAKE MANDATORY THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OF ANY PERSON FAILING TO FILE A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT REPORT REQUIRED BY LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 26 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 628 of the acts of 1965, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the third paragraph and in-  
4 serting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 The registrar may revoke or shall suspend for a period of  
6 thirty days the license of any person violating any provision  
7 of this section. For subsequent violations, the registrar may  
8 revoke or shall suspend the license of such a person for a  
9 period of no less than ninety days and no more than one year.
