AN ACT TO AMEND EXEMPTIONS TO CERTAIN POSITIONS IN MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENTS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 198 of the Acts of 1976, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting at the end of the twenty-third
4 clause, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 115 of the acts of
5 1975, the following clause: —

6 “provided that such employment of a staff assistant or as-
7 sistants employed by such department shall be approved by a
8 two-thirds majority vote of the City Council of such city and
9 by its Mayor.
