AN ACT CLARIFYING THE STATE'S RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or General Law to the con-
2 trary, no state employee shall be prevented from joining the
3 state employees retirement system, "system" as defined in
4 section one of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, because
5 of age. This section shall not apply to any employee unless
6 and until he shall pay into the annuity savings fund of the
7 system the make-up payments, if any, required by chapter
8 thirty-two of the General Laws.
