## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A PER DIEM SALARY FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF SOCIAL WORKERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 13, Section 83 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by deleting the entire aforementioned Section and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following new section: —  
4 *Section 83.* Subject to the requirements of Section 21 of  
5 Chapter 30 of the General Laws, and subject to Section 31 of  
6 Chapter 29, each member of the Board shall receive fifty  
7 dollars for each day or part of a day actually spent in the  
8 performance of duties, but in any one year not more than  
9 fifteen hundred dollars shall be paid to any member. Each  
10 member shall be reimbursed for actual expenses reasonably  
11 incurred in the performance of his/her duties as a member  
12 or on behalf of the Board.
