**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT STATE, METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION, AND CAPITOL POLICE, AND REGISTRY INSPECTORS SHALL BE PAID A SALARY COMMENSURATE WITH SALARIES PAID TO POLICE IN THE CITIES OF BOSTON, CAMBRIDGE, AND QUINCY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 the state police, metropolitan district commission police and
- 3 capitol police, and registry inspectors shall be paid a salary
- 4 commensurate with salaries paid to police in the cities of
- 5 Boston, Cambridge and Quincy.
