AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BUILDING FOR THE TOWN OFFICES, LIBRARY, AND MEETING HALL IN THE TOWN OF NEW BRAINTREE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Secretaries of the Executive Offices of Transportation
2 and Construction, and Community Affairs are hereby author-
3 ized and directed, subject to appropriation, to construct and
4 originally equip a building to provide suitable and adequate
5 facilities for the town offices, library, and meeting hall for
6 the town of New Braintree including landscaping, parking,
7 and furnishings. Any sums available or received by said
8 secretaries from the Federal Government shall be expended
9 for the purpose of this act.
