**AN ACT EXEMPTING INCOME FROM NON-CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS
FROM TAXATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 5 of chapter 555 of the
3 acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by adding the follow-
4 ing clause: —

5 (i) Income from any non-contributory annuity, pension, or
6 retirement allowance paid by the commonwealth or any city,
7 town, district, or authority.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to taxable years ending on
2 and after December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and sev-
3 enty-four.

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 22 of the General Laws of the State of Michigan, as amended by section 2 of chapter 22 of the General Laws of the State of Michigan, is hereby amended by adding the following clause:—

(b) Because from any non-conflicting source or sources, the University of Michigan shall have the right to use any material contained herein for the purpose of research and study only, without charge, for the purpose of research and study only.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the date of its passage and to all other laws which may be enacted hereafter which are in conflict with the provisions of this act.
