By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1485) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to increase the earning capacity of individuals on the elderly abatement, so-called. Taxation.

**AN ACT INCREASING THE EARNING CAPACITY OF INDIVIDUALS ON
THE ELDERLY ABATEMENT, SO-CALLED.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 347
3 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by striking out,
4 in proviso (B) of the first sentence, the words "six thousand
5 dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words "eight thou-
6 sand dollars", and by striking out the words "seven thousand
7 dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words "nine thou-
8 sand dollars", and by further amending by striking out, in the
9 second sentence, the words "six thousand dollars" and insert-
10 ing in place thereof the words "eight thousand dollars".
