AN ACT RELATIVE TO MANNING OF PASSENGER TRAINS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section one hundred fifty-four of chapter one hundred
2 sixty of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter four hundred sixty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 six, is hereby amended by striking out the words "two cars in
5 a" in the first sentence.
