AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A THIRD AND FOURTH ASSISTANT CLERK FOR  
THE DISTRICT COURT OF CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 10 of chapter  
2 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 176 of chap-  
3 ter 478 of the acts of 1978, is hereby amended by striking  
4 out the line reading "district court of Chelsea".

1 SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of said section 10 of said  
2 chapter 218, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting  
3 after the line reading "municipal court of the Charlestown  
4 district" the following line: — district court of Chelsea.
