1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, the senior judge of the Norfolk probate and fam-
4 ily court, a justice of the superior court department to be ap-
5 pointed by the governor and the register of probate, is hereby
6 established for the purpose of making an investigation and
7 study relative to the construction of a new courthouse to
8 house the superior court and probate court and family court
9 departments in Norfolk county and the feasibility of locating
10 said courthouse in the city of Quincy, selecting a primary and
11 alternate choice for said location.
