AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF THE PROVISION LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BARNSTABLE MAY EXPEND FOR THE CAPE COD PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 453 of the acts of 1965 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by chapter 74 of the acts of 1978, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence: —

5 Beginning with the fiscal year commencing on January first,
6 nineteen hundred and sixty-five, to meet the expenses in-
7 curred under this act there may annually be expended from
8 the treasury of Barnstable county, subject to appropriation,
9 such sums as may be appropriated annually thereafter.
