By Mr. Foley, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1766) of Daniel J. Foley for legislation to require insurance companies, agents and brokers to notify the insured of service charges in connection with the issuing and delivery of motor vehicle insurance policies. Insurance.

AN ACT REQUIRING INSURANCE COMPANIES, AGENTS AND BROKERS TO NOTIFY THE INSURED OF SERVICE CHARGES IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUING AND DELIVERY OF MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 113P of said chapter the following: —
- 3 *Section 113Q.* For motor vehicle insurance policies or bonds
- 4 as defined in section thirty-four A and thirty-four O of chap-
- 5 ter ninety, any company, agent or broker who charges for
- 6 services performed for the benefit of the insured which is not
- 7 included in the premium charges for such insurance shall
- 8 notify the insured in writing and describe such service and the
- 9 amount charged by the company, agent or broker for such
- 10 service. Such notice shall be incorporated in the form for ap-
- 11 plication for insurance which is used by said company, agent
- 12 or broker.
