AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The last paragraph of section 3 of chapter 150E, as appear-  
2 ing in chapter 478 of the Acts of 1978, is hereby amended  
3 by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following sentence: The appropriate bargaining  
5 units for judicial employees shall be a professional unit com-  
6 posed of all probation officers, a professional unit composed  
7 of all court officers, and a unit composed of all nonmana-  
8 gerial or nonconfidential staff and clerical personnel em-  
9 ployed by the Judiciary; provided that court officers in the  
10 Superior Court department for Suffolk and Middlesex coun-  
11 ties shall be represented by such other bargaining units as  
12 they may elect.
