AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MAYNARD TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR BORROWING A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY IN ANTICIPATION OF FEDERAL GRANTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWERAGE TREATMENT PLANT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of section three
2 of Chapter seventy-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 forty-five, to the contrary, the Treasurer of the Town of May-
4 nard with the approval of the Board of Selectmen of said
5 Town, is hereby authorized to renew Federal Aid Anticipa-
6 tion Notes of said Town in the amount of two hundred and
7 fifty-five thousand seven hundred and twenty-nine dollars,
8 payable not more than one year from their dates, in order to
9 pay the Federal Aid anticipation notes of said Town dated
10 July twenty-second, nineteen hundred and seventy-five in the
11 amount of five hundred thousand dollars and Federal Aid
12 anticipation notes, in said Town dated October sixth, nine-
13 teen hundred and seventy-five, in the amount of two hundred
14 thousand dollars which were renewed on January twenty-
15 second, nineteen hundred and seventy-six in the amount of
16 seven hundred thousand dollars, and payable on January
17 twenty-second, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven which
18 was renewed on January twenty-second nineteen hundred and
19 seventy-seven and payable on July twenty-first, nineteen hun-
20 dred and seventy-seven which was most recently renewed on
21 March thirty-first, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven in
22 the amount of two hundred and fifty-five thousand, seven

23 hundred and twenty-nine dollars and payable on July twenty-
24 first, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight. Notes issued under
25 this act for a period of less than one year may be renewed
26 or paid from time to time by the issue of other notes, pro-
27 vided that the period from the date of an original note issued
28 under this act to the maturity of any note issued to renew or
29 pay the same debt shall not exceed one year which was most
30 recently renewed on July twenty-first nineteen hundred and
31 seventy-eight and payable July twenty-first nineteen hundred
32 and seventy-nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take place upon its passage.
