At a legal meeting of the qualified voters of the Town of Framingham, held September 12, 1979 the following business was transacted under Article 12.

Article 12. To see if the Town will vote to have the Board of Selectmen petition the General Court to amend Section 4 of the Non-Partisan Act by striking out the words "twenty-first day" and substituting the words "twenty-eighth day" so the amended sentence will now read:

SECTION 4. Nomination papers shall be filed with the Town Clerk not later than five o'clock in the afternoon of the twenty-eighth day preceding the preliminary election.

Pass any vote or take any action relative thereto.

Sponsor: Board of Selectmen.

9/12/79 Voted: that the Town have the Board of Selectmen petition the General Court to amend Section 4 of Chapter 34 of the Acts of 1979 (An Act Authorizing Non-Partisan Preliminary Elections in the Town of Framingham) by striking out the words "twenty-first day" and substituting the words "twenty-eighth day" so the amended sentence will now read:

SECTION 4. Nomination papers shall be filed with the Town Clerk not later than five o'clock in the afternoon of the twenty-eighth day preceding the preliminary election.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine.

### AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW AUTHORIZING NONPARTISAN PRELIMINARY ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section four of Chapter 34 of the acts of nineteen hundred
- 2 and seventy-nine is hereby amended by striking out the first
- 3 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 4 Nomination papers shall be filed with the town clerk not
- 5 later than five o'clock in the afternoon of the twenty-eighth
- 6 day preceding the preliminary election.
