By Mr. Lewis, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 109) of Arthur Joseph Lewis, Jr., for legislation to authorize and direct the Division of Industrial Accidents to promulgate stricter qualifications for certain persons seeking licenses as self-insurers under the Workmen's Compensation Act. AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS TO PROMULGATE STRICTER QUALIFICATIONS FOR CERTAIN PERSONS SEEKING LICENSES AS SELF-INSURERS UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The division of industrial accidents is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to promulgate stricted qualifications for any persons,
- 3 excluding municipalities, public authorities, and the common-
- 4 wealth, who seek licenses as self-insurers under the workmen's
- 5 compensation act as conditions for granting same.
