AN ACT TO RE-IDENTIFY PULMONARY DAMAGE AS A MAJOR SINGULAR
CATEGORY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36 of Chapter 152 is hereby amended by
2 adding Article (l)'s segment after Article (k)'s paragraph as
3 amended by Chapter 741 of 1972, to read: (l) For twenty per-
4 cent or more loss of lung capacity due to work environment
5 hazards, such as chemical or dust, the sum of forty thousand
6 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act will take upon its passage.
