AN ACT RELATIVE TO COUNTY EXPENDITURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 29 of Chapter 35 as most recently amended by
2 Chapter 15 of the Acts of 1978 is hereby further amended by
3 striking the second sentence and inserting in place thereof
4 the following: —

5 At the closing of a county treasurer's books on July tenth,
6 the balance to the credit of each appropriation shall become
7 a part of the general unappropriated balance in the county
8 treasury except funds which are assigned from the reserve
9 fund which are later reimbursed in the following cases: —

10 (a) where the county pays a judgment of a court under
11 eminent domain proceedings for road improvements on a
12 county road because of requests by the selectmen of a town
13 or the mayor and city council of a city with the town or city
14 thereby reimbursing the county; and

15 (b) where the county pays initial starting costs of a Com-
16 prehensive Employment Training Act program or a federal or
17 state grant from the reserve fund and is thereafter reim-
18 bursed. Funds which are reimbursed in these two cases to the
19 county shall be redeposited in the reserve fund of said county.
