AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW RELATIVE TO FUNDING RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR SPECIAL NEEDS STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 of Chapter 71B of the General Laws, as added by
2 Section 11 of Chapter 766 of the Acts of 1972, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the first sentence of the second para-
4 graph, and inserting in place thereof the following new sen-
5 tence: —

6 Such programs shall be under the direction and approval of
7 the division of special education and the department shall re-
8 imburse said cities and towns for all the costs thereof, includ-
9 ing transportation of said children to and from the site of such
10 program on each day said program is held.
