RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO STUDY
VOCATIONAL EDUCATION.

- 1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
- 2 members of the senate, five members of the house or repre-
- 3 sentatives and five persons to be appointed by the governor,
- 4 to investigate and study the educational processes conducted
- 5 by vocational educational schools within the commonwealth.
- 6 Said commission shall make special emphasis upon the fiscal
- 7 contributions made by the commonwealth in order to relieve
- 8 the cost from the cities and towns.
- 9 Said commission may travel within or without the com-
- 10 monwealth and be provided with space in the statehouse.
