**AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE FACTS TO BE SHOWN ON BIRTH
CERTIFICATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 1 of chapter 46 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 161 of the
3 acts of 1977, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sen-
5 tence: — In the record of births, date of record, date of birth,
6 place of birth, name of child, his sex, names, places of birth
7 and residence of his parents, the maiden name of the mother,
8 the occupation of the father and, upon written request of the
9 mother, the occupation of the mother.
