AN ACT ESTABLISHING SECURE FACILITIES FOR THE EXTENDED CARE OF HARD CORE JUVENILE DRUG PUSHERS AND HARD CORE JUVENILE DRUG ADDICTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Department of Youth Services is hereby authorized to
- 2 establish twenty-four (24) hour supervisory facilities for hard
- 3 core drug pushers and drug addicts, under the age of eighteen,
- 4 who have failed to respond to other forms of community help.
- 5 These centers would have vocational and rehabilitation pro-
- 6 grams with educational courses equivalent to a high school
- 7 education.
- 8 The Center's program shall be directed from a policy of
- 9 complete isolation from harmful drugs. Where advisable, half-
- 10 way houses, rehabilitation centers, and other existing facili-
- 11 ties might be converted to secure settings as a money saving
- 12 measure.
- 13 These Extended Care Centers shall be staffed with certified
- 14 teachers of excellent character.
