## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-one.

AN ACT TO ENSURE THE TIMELY PREPARATION, PRINTING, AND FORWARDING OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE INFORMATION GUIDE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 11 of Chapter 175E of the General Laws, as amend-  
2 ed, is hereby further amended by striking out in the first sen-  
3 tence the word "may" and substituting the word "shall" and  
4 by inserting after the first sentence a new sentence as follows:  
5 — The commissioner shall establish such rules and prescribe  
6 or approve such language in sufficiently timely fashion to per-  
7 mit the companies to include said information guide with each  
8 new and renewal application for insurance for the next cal-  
9 endar year.
