AN ACT ESTABLISHING A VETERANS' BOARD OF APPEALS IN THE  
VARIOUS TOWNS AND CITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Add Section 112B to Chapter 41 of the General Laws. Vet-  
2 erans' Board of Appeals to consist of five members in a town  
3 appointed by the Selectmen for a four year term, in a city  
4 appointed by the City Council for a four year term. Any vet-  
5 eran denied his or her rights under Sections 112 and 112A  
6 shall have the rights to appeal, if not satisfied to: (1) Veter-  
7 ans' Board of Appeals, (2) Board of Selectmen, (3) Superior  
8 Court.
